SOME **History**

In 2015, Dr. Michael Garver, a pediatrician from Great Falls, Montana, developed an interest in visiting South Africa. Eventually through friends in Great Falls and Brad Rauch with Mission Builders International, he met Rufus Luttig, founder of Hunt SA. After hearing that a team from Missoula would soon be going to South Africa, Dr. Garver asked to join them. What the team found in the area of Eastern Cape called the Transkei was an incredible need, especially with the children, mostly orphans.

Not knowing what to expect, the Dr. brought with him a small crate filled with general medical supplies and along with the other team members, went to work treating mostly young people. What began as a "once in a lifetime trip" turned into an overwhelming desire to see Mobile Medical Mission teams returning regularly to serve wherever they were led throughout eastern South Africa.



By the time the second trip was scheduled, another team including Dr. Garver was in place. Medicine was able to be purchased at a reasonable cost in South Africa. The team then developed a target plan that could be repeated for future trips. From the time they arrived to the day they flew home (16 days later), there were 356 children examined and treated. A computer file was created for each child including a picture, weight, height and examination results. The team encountered typical Third World conditions including children infected with scabies, open wounds, worms, HIV, malnutrition and respiratory problems. Lots of hours, lots of travel time, and lots of satisfaction knowing they were making a difference.

- + Depart from USA

- + Set up and serve at location #1 Village
- + Set up and serve at location #2 Village
- Drive to Jehovah-Jireh Haven Children's Home at Alexandria, S.A. Set up and serve.
- One day leisurely drive to HUNT SA Lodge.
- ◆ Free day at lodge. Roundtable discussion.
- Morning "Outdoor Chapel". Leave for Schotia Safari photoshoot and ADDO Elephant Park to spend night.
- * Drive to Port Elizabeth. Visit Door of Hope Orphanage
- Next morning walking the beach or shopping and leave for the airport around noon for departure.
- + Arrive back in the U.S. 16 days total.
